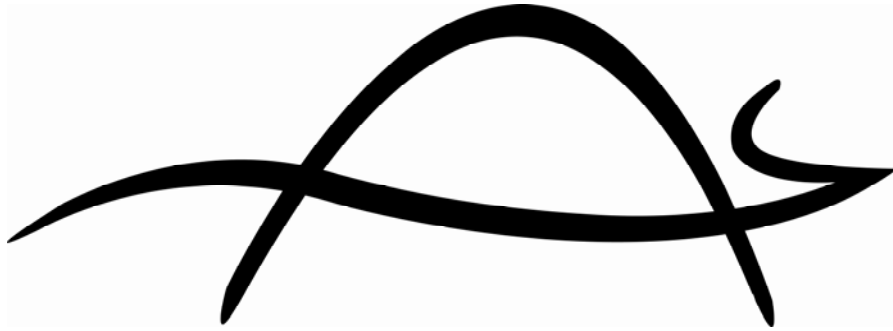

## 2009 Armadillo DISTRICT CAMPOREE

### General Description

The 1st Annual Armadillo District Camporee is a great opportunity for camping, patrol competition, Webelos recruitment, and inter-unit fellowship for Troops, Venturing Crews and Webelos.

The theme of this year's Camporee is **Space Scouts**. All judging, unless noted otherwise, will incorporate a component of theme inclusion. When considering the theme think of Hollywood type space scouts, i.e. Star Wars and the Jetsons, not Neil Armstrong and NASA. Events and activities will incorporate the theme as well as scouting skills.

Units will have a choice of one of three camping styles each with its own judging criteria:

- a) The traditional Jamboree style – the formal camping that units have used at past camporees complete with gateways.
- b) A low impact Leave No Trace style- backpack into the campsite, simplicity, and a light touch.
- c) Adherence to the Space Scouts theme – for the creative among us.

### Events

There will be four segments of Camporee events. The events will be scattered around the camp and not revealed until the patrols are released on Sat AM:

- a) Morning events will be oriented around teamwork and problem solving.
- b) Lunchtime events will be paper/trivia/academically oriented
- c) Afternoon events will be more competition oriented with a different patrol representative (champion) competing for the patrol in each event.
- d) There will be a skit competition with preliminaries in the pre-dinner time period and the finals held at the campfire (think American Idol with the appropriate colorful judges). It is expected that skits will be designed prior to arrival at the Camporee.

Events will be based around scout and life skills and knowledge with the intent of involving all scouts. An attempt will be made to attach all events to the Space Scout

theme. (**Older Scouts:** It is hoped that an all day Ironman competition will be available for older scouts who choose not to participate in the patrol events. This will include physical and mental challenges designed for boys 15 to 18.)

Events will be run by adult and older scout volunteers provided by the units. This will be organized at a meeting held a week or two prior to the Camporee with final assignments made at a meeting on Friday evening prior to the Scoutmasters/SPL meeting. Each unit is expected to provide two or more volunteers to help.

### **Food**

The Camporee will provide a central pancake breakfast on Sunday morning. Patrols will need to carry a trail type lunch to eat at a central location on Saturday. All other meals are the responsibility of each unit.

### **Water**

Water is scarce at Wolf Mountain. Units must bring adequate water to carry them through the weekend. We are hoping to have some water buffalos, but this is not guaranteed at this time.

### **Cost**

The cost of the Camporee is \$15.00 per person (for Scouts, Webelos, and Adults), which will be paid at the registration table upon arrival at the Camporee site. This cost includes Sunday Breakfast, Awards, Patches, Supplies, Sanitation, Printing and Postage. Should cost considerations be an issue in unit participation, please contact the Armadillo District leadership to discuss alternative arrangements.

### **Webelos**

There will be a Webelos program on Saturday and Webelos are encouraged to camp and/or participate with Troops.

### **Order of the Arrow**

There will be an OA call out and probably a Brotherhood ceremony. Arrangements for elections should be made with the Armadillo Chapter advisor, Doug Schreffler, [dschref@swbell.net](mailto:dschref@swbell.net).
