The Eagle project

Can be undertaken immediately after the scout has achieved life but

Can't be started until District approves





The project proposal

- Should be thoroughly vetted by the unit leaders before it hits my inbox
- Good idea to have the candidate present his project before the troop committee
- This is the candidate's project the committee (or parent) doesn't design it.

It is his to succeed or fail





The project proposal (continued)

- Although project can be handwritten, it must be legible
- Everything, including the contact page, must be completed
- MUST have signatures
- When the scout contacts me he MUST copy his unit leaders and/or parents





Funding

- Often overlooked part of the proposal
- <u>MUST</u> be completed if donations of ANY TYPE or provided for the project by individuals or entities except for the following:

The scout

His family

His unit

The beneficiary





Timing

- Although we can often quickly turn around proposal reviews for scouts close to aging out, I cannot guarantee that...
- Depends on state of the proposal
- Do I have reviewers available
- Can the project, as proposed, actually be done before the candidate ages out
- Need to take into account holidays, weather, and logistics





 Once approved, the project reviewer will provide the candidate several files with next step instructions

 Information is also available on the District and Council web sites





The Eagle Board of Review

Can be scheduled after CAC has verified the Candidates Eagle Application

and

Can be held up to 90 days after the Candidate's 18th birthday





The Eagle Application

- Must be completed, signed, and turned into CAC (Keri Smeaton) for review
- Keri needs the signed application and
- Documentation indicating the scout has officially earned all ranks and required MBs





Application can be completed and turned in after the scout reaches 18, but all Eagle requirements must be completed before 18 years

- 6 months life
- 6 month recognized position of responsibility/unit leadership
- ALL required MBs
- Completed Eagle project
- SM conference





Carefully review the application with the scout. Pay attention to the following:

- Are all dates correct
- Are the leadership positions valid
 (i.e., assistant patrol leader
 doesn't count)
- Are the references correct





Once I receive Keri's confirmation letter

I will contact the scout, his leader(s), and sometimes parents with next step instructions

need letters of recommendation CONFIDENTIAL – should be sent directly to me

need life statement
Should already be done for the SM conference

need COPY of completed and fully signed workbook





 I will NOT schedule a Board until I have all his materials

 I do have a record when the scout ages out, and if necessary, will notify him and his unit to remind him





Board Requirements

Main thing is for the scout to be prepared with his required documentation

- Original eagle app
- Original workbook
- Copies of the workbook

The district chair will have all other materials
